There will be a number of high school graduation ceremonies in the area this week – Cannon Falls on May 30 and Randolph HS on Saturday the 31st. Hastings will have theirs on Friday, June 6th. Congratulations to everyone involved!



I've been invited to a number of parties, as I am sure many readers have been. I've never given a commencement address (except at my own high school graduation) and I'm not sure of everything I would want to say to them. So many things so often said are true but have become trite, such as a new beginning, looking to the future, drawing upon the past, holding on to lessons already learned, facing new challenges. The word graduate itself comes from grade or step, which implies not a completion, but continuing in some process. We always need to learn, to be open to ideas, test them, take what is good and expose the rest. One of the purposes of education, whether in a classroom or not, is to help us think critically. What is right, and what is wrong? What is true? A diploma **doesn't necessarily give us that, but a life balanced between faith and education gets us close.** I always encourage those moving on to college to pack Jesus along on the trip, and for those who are still a year or two from graduation, to begin to pray about what the next step will be. God has a definite interest and opinion as to what you do and where you go.

Finally, this is a challenge I found on a bookmark given me long ago. It was about religious vocations, but it works well for many things. *"If not you, who? If not now, when? If not for the Kingdom, why? Dare the Dream."*

Memorial Day was for many years known as Decoration Day, and held on May 30th. It was a day to decorate the graves of those soldiers who died in the Civil War. It became the standard day to do this in the Northern States, while those states that had been part

of the Confederacy held similar events for their Civil War dead on various days, not wanting to participate in a day that celebrated the northern soldiers. After World War I it became a day to honor all those who died while in service to their country for all wars going back to the American Revolution. It finally became a federal holiday in 1971, set on the final Monday of the month. We will have prayers and remembrances in our three cemeteries; see the community page for times. Bring lawn chairs for the Masses.

Please welcome our Missionary Speaker, Fr. Jason Marco from the Diocese of San Carlos, Negros in the Philippines, at our Masses next weekend. He will be making the appeal to help his diocese in various needs, including building a seminary, supporting Mission Schools in the remote areas of the diocese catering to children of indigenous people and farmers who have no access to basic education, and evangelization through School and Community Catechesis, and Social Programs like feeding, skills and livelihood training, community-based health program, disaster risk reduction and management, good governance, care for environment, and the like. Your most generous response will surely contribute to our goal of building the kingdom of God here on earth.

A reminder again that we start our new schedule on the weekend on June 7/8, and continue through Labor Day weekend: Vermillion at 5:00 Saturday; New Trier at 8:00 on Sunday; Hampton at 10:00 on Sunday. Confessions for Summer will be Saturday morning at 9:00 in New Trier; Tuesday Evening at 6:00 in Vermillion and Saturday Evening at 4:00 in Vermillion, and Friday mornings 9:00-9:30 in Hampton. Going forward, the Saturday afternoon confessions will travel with the Saturday evening Mass. Adjustments will be made in Hampton as interest requires.

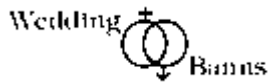

In the Catholic Church, the baptized are encouraged to remember through prayer, ritual and permanent symbols those who have gone before us in faith. There are a variety of meaningful ways to permanently and reverently memorialize the life of a departed loved one, such as seasonal tributes including flowers at Memorial Day and wreaths during the Christmas season.



Some general guidelines to follow at the cemetery:

- ☞ No trees or bushes may be planted in cemetery except with the permission of cemetery board.
- ☞ All floral designs, flowers or plants must be placed so as not to inhibit grass cutting. (Glass decorations, figurines, vigil lights or solar-powered lights, etc. are not allowed in some cemeteries for safety reasons.)
- ☞ Deposit debris in trash cans.
- ☞ The cemetery reserves the right to remove any decorations, plants or planters, etc.

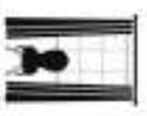
