**Guidelines and Expectations**

1. Start to say the rosary 25 minutes before mass. This way, you will be finished at least 5 minutes before mass.
2. Mon/Sat – Joyful Mysteries, Tues/Fri – Sorrowful Mysteries, Wed/Sun – Glorious Mysteries, Thurs – Luminous Mysteries (Add a link to the rosary page on the web.)
3. Speak loud and clear.
4. Scheduling – The coordinator does all the scheduling and gives this schedule to the parish secretary. It may work out just to have a set rotation. If you know you will be on vacation, let the coordinator know so you are not scheduled during your vacation. The schedule is made up 3 months ahead. If you can't make the scheduled time, you are responsible for finding a replacement.

**How to say the rosary**

1. Sign of the Cross
2. Apostles Creed
3. Our Father
4. Hail Mary (3x)                    (For Faith, Hope, and Love)
5. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be world without end.
6. O my Jesus forgive us our sins and save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of thy mercy
7. Announce the mystery (see above for which mysteries should be used for the given day.)
8. Our Father
9. Hail Mary (10X)
10. Glory be ...
11. O my Jesus ....
12. Repeat numbers 6 – 10 for the other 4 mysteries.
13. Hail Holy Queen
14. Misc other prayers
15. Sign of the Cross
